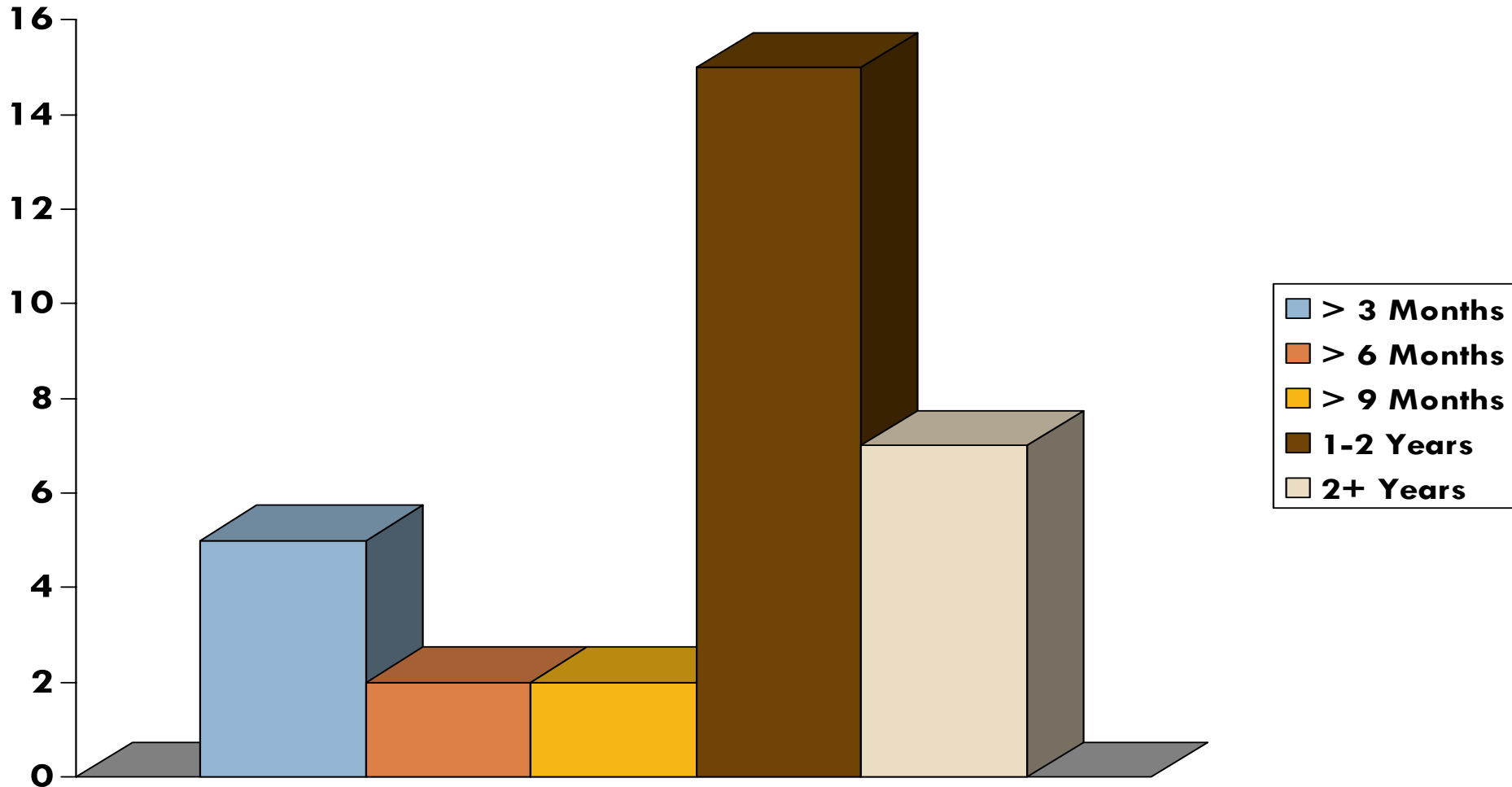

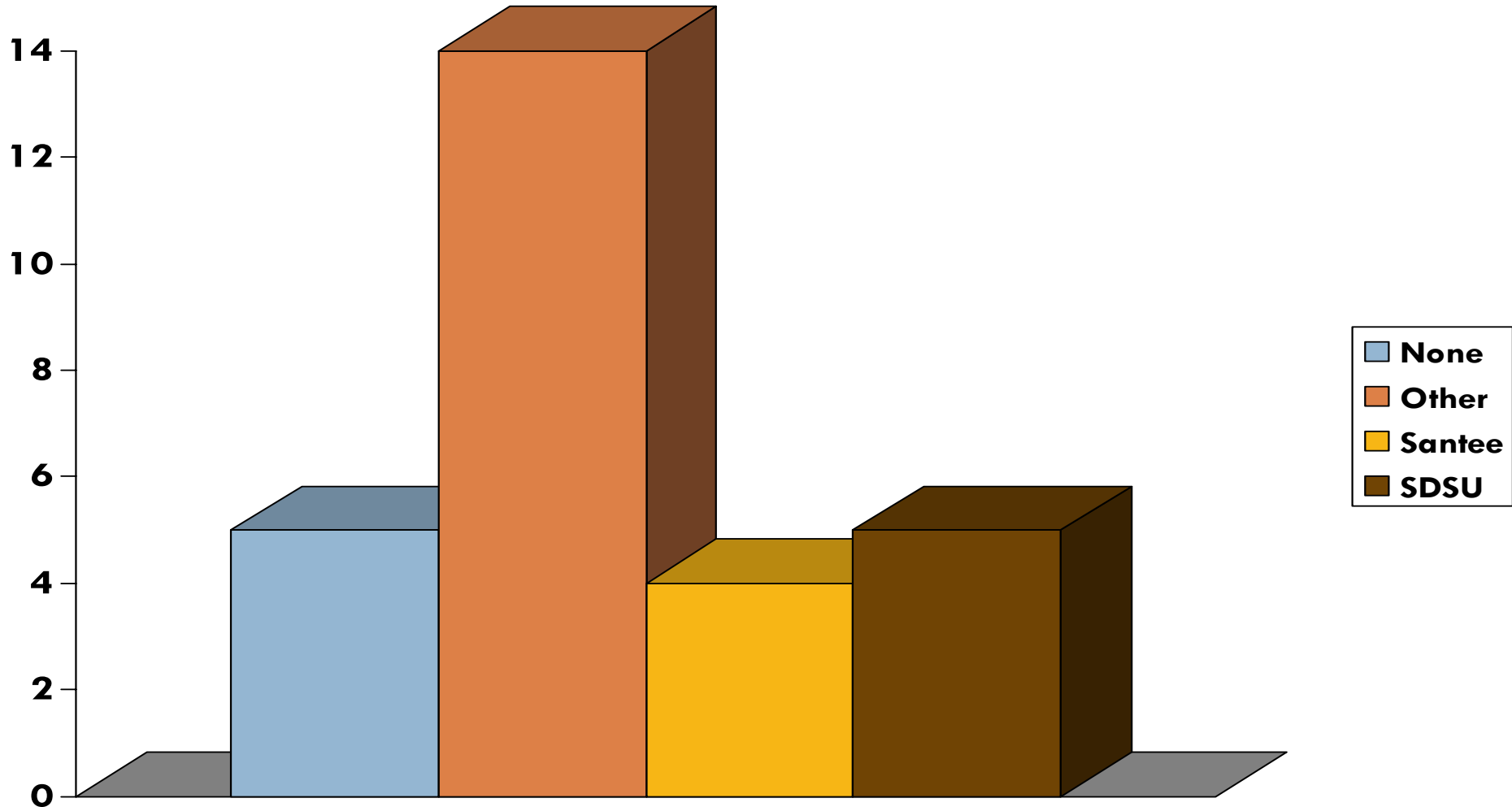

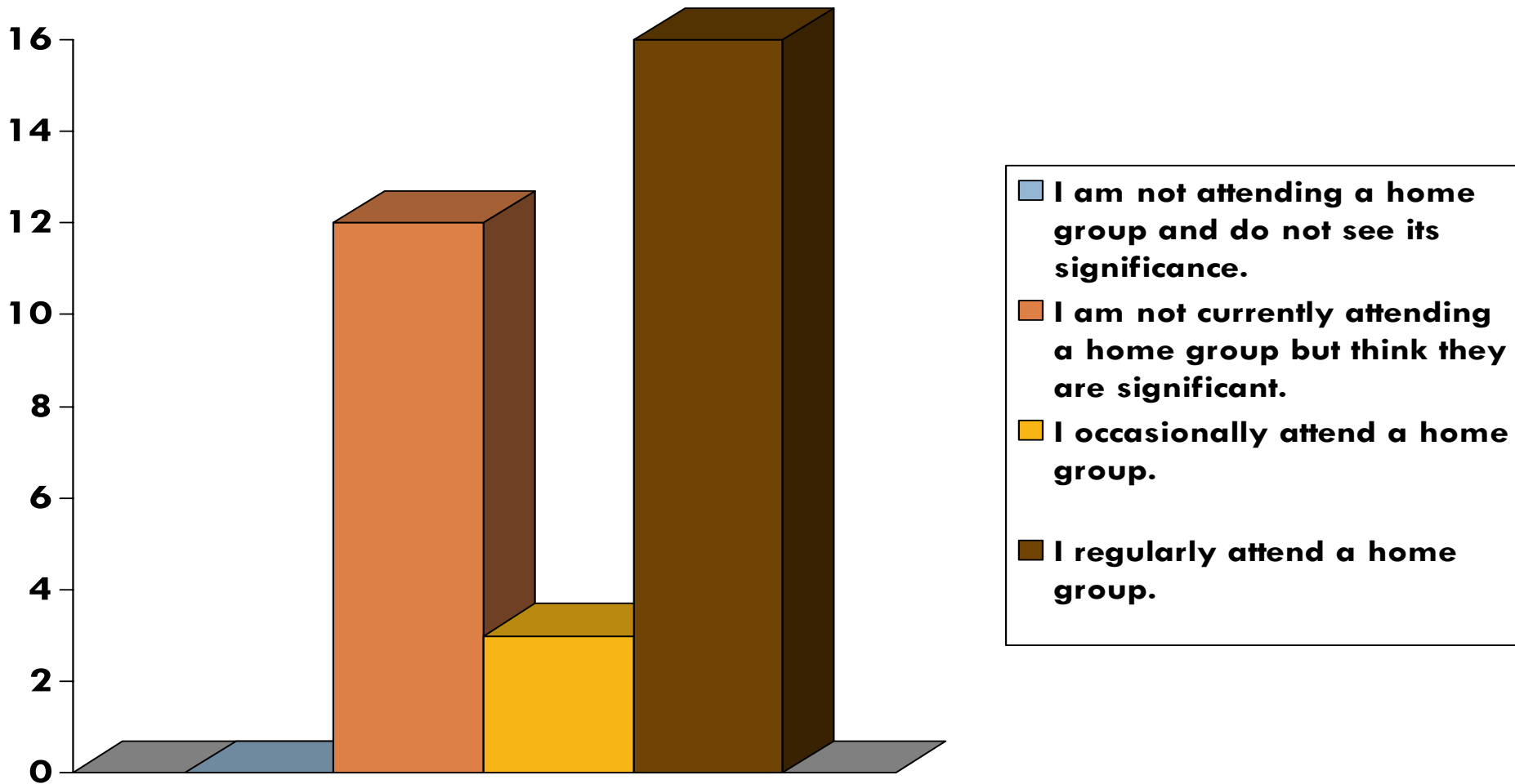
# How long have you been attending Kaleo?



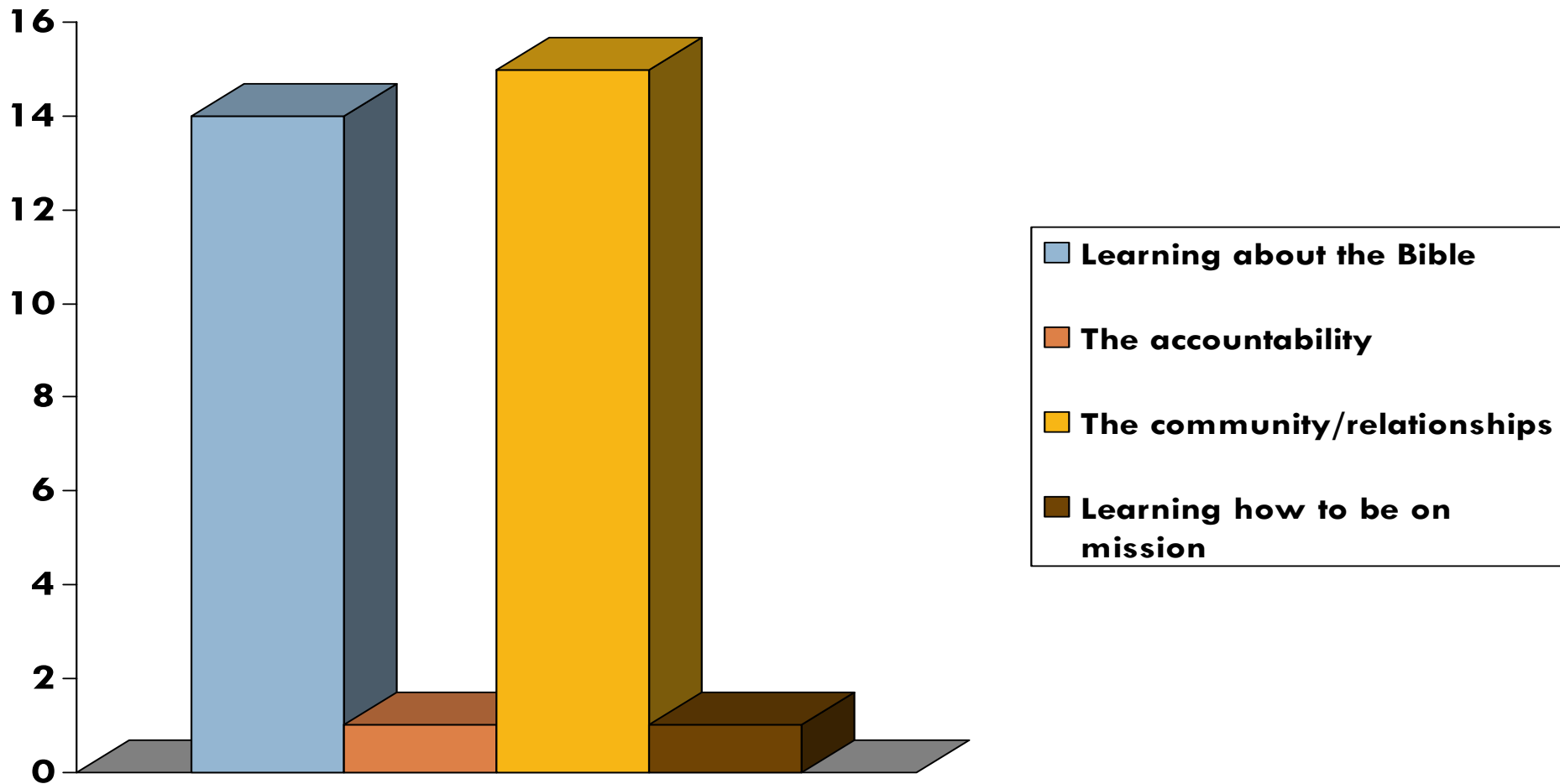
# Which home group do you attend?



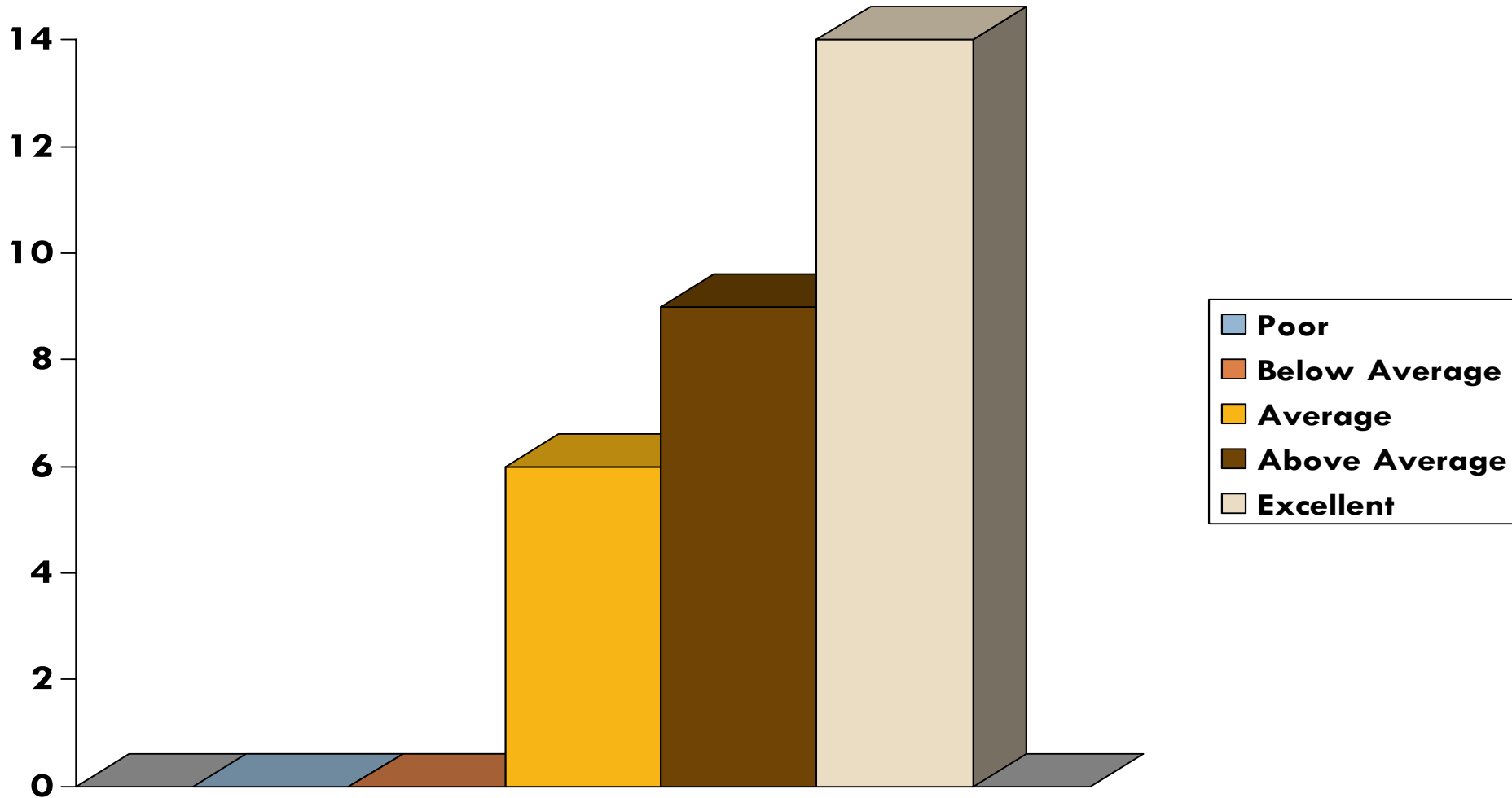
# Do you attend a home group?



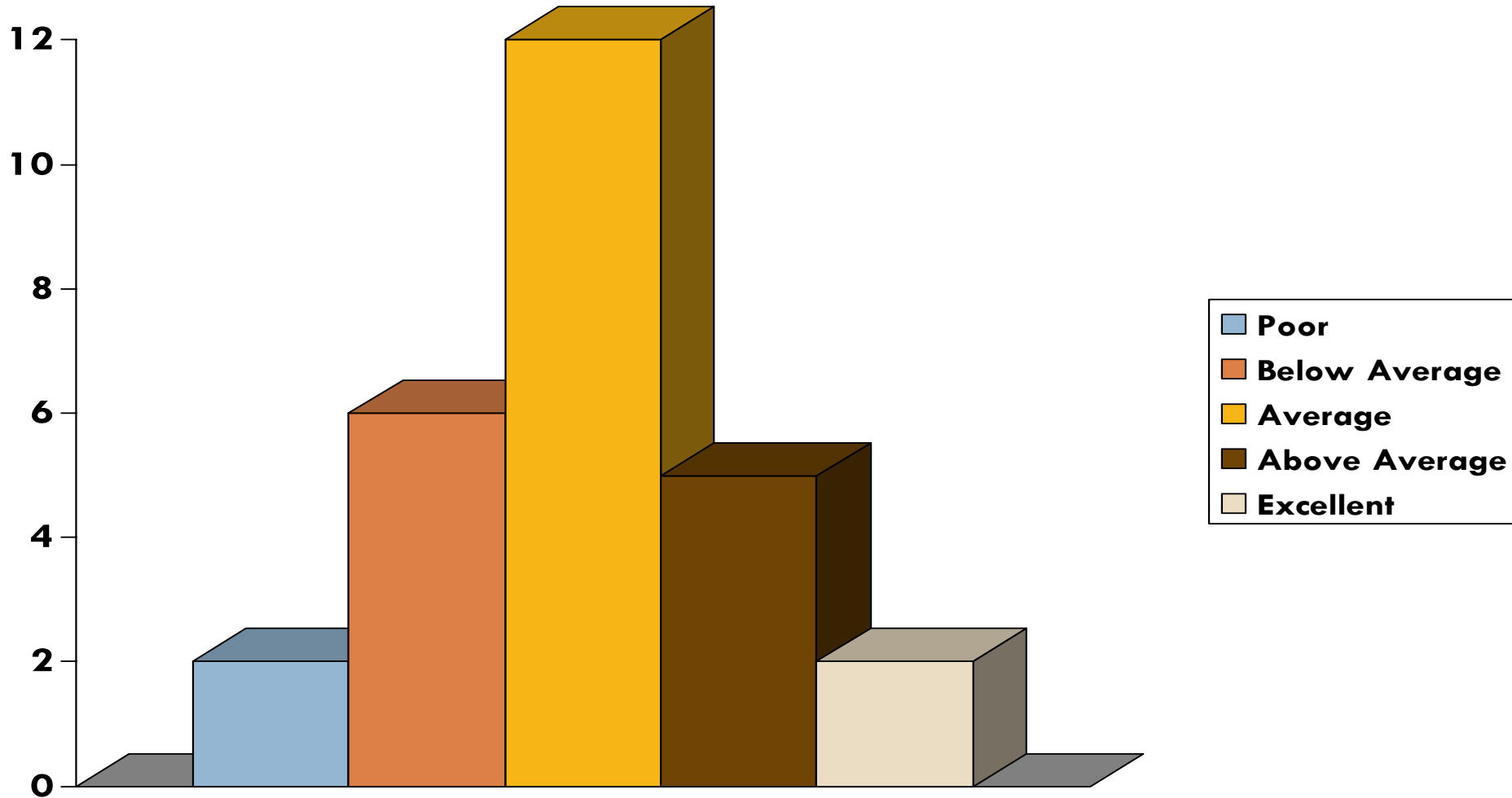
# What motivates you to attend a home group?



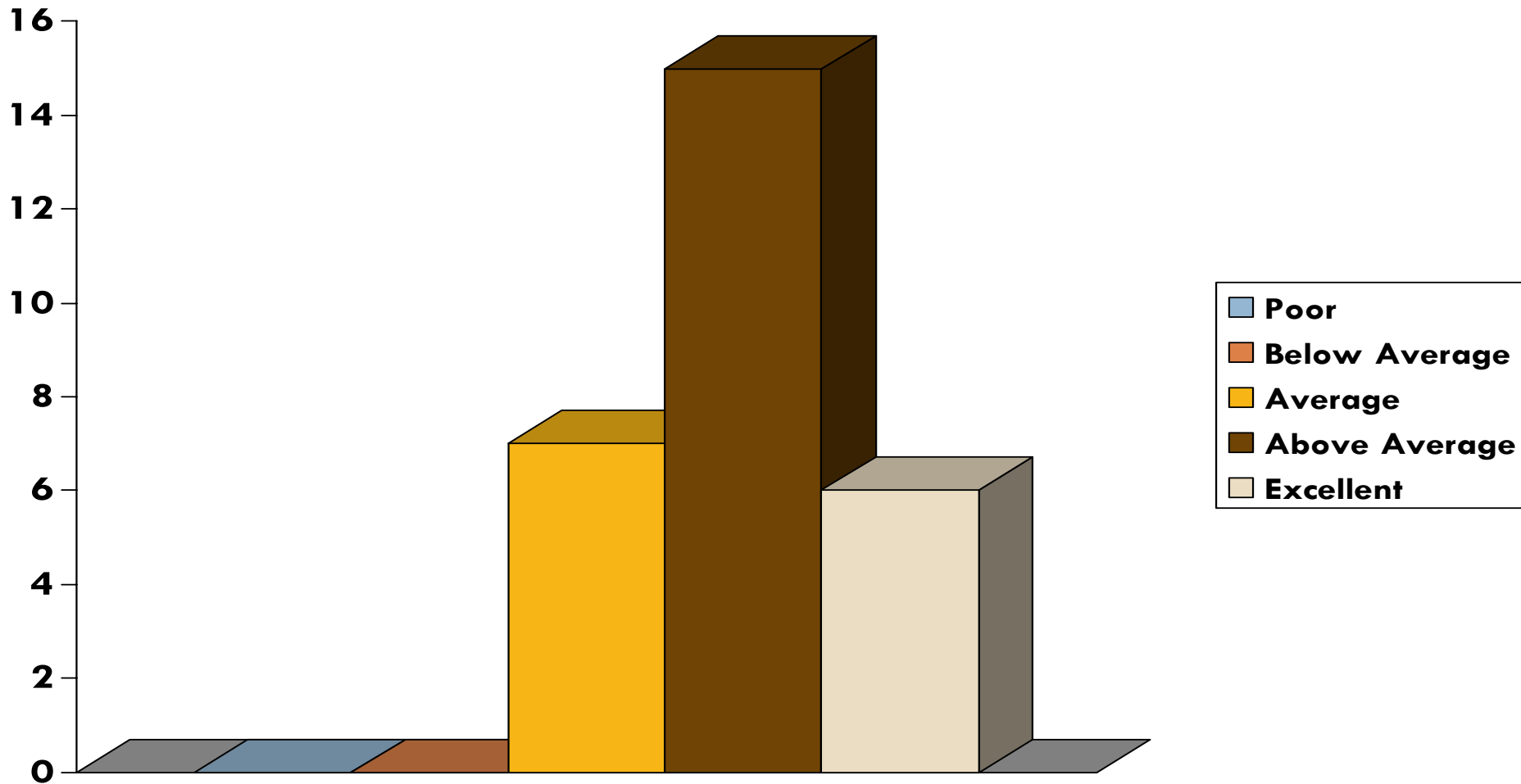
# How well are Kaleo's home groups assisting you in learning about the Bible?



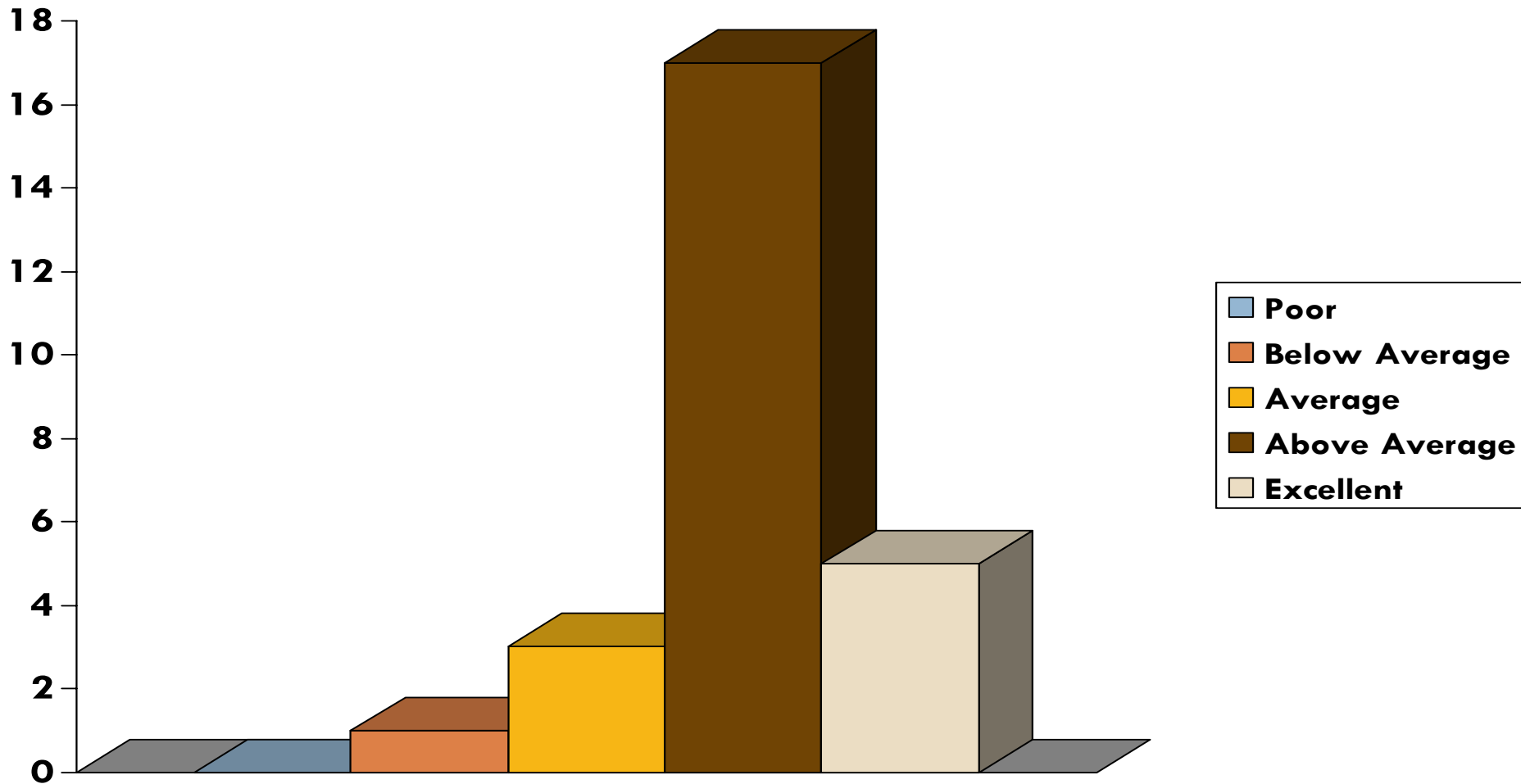
# How well do you think Kaleo's home groups are fostering accountability?



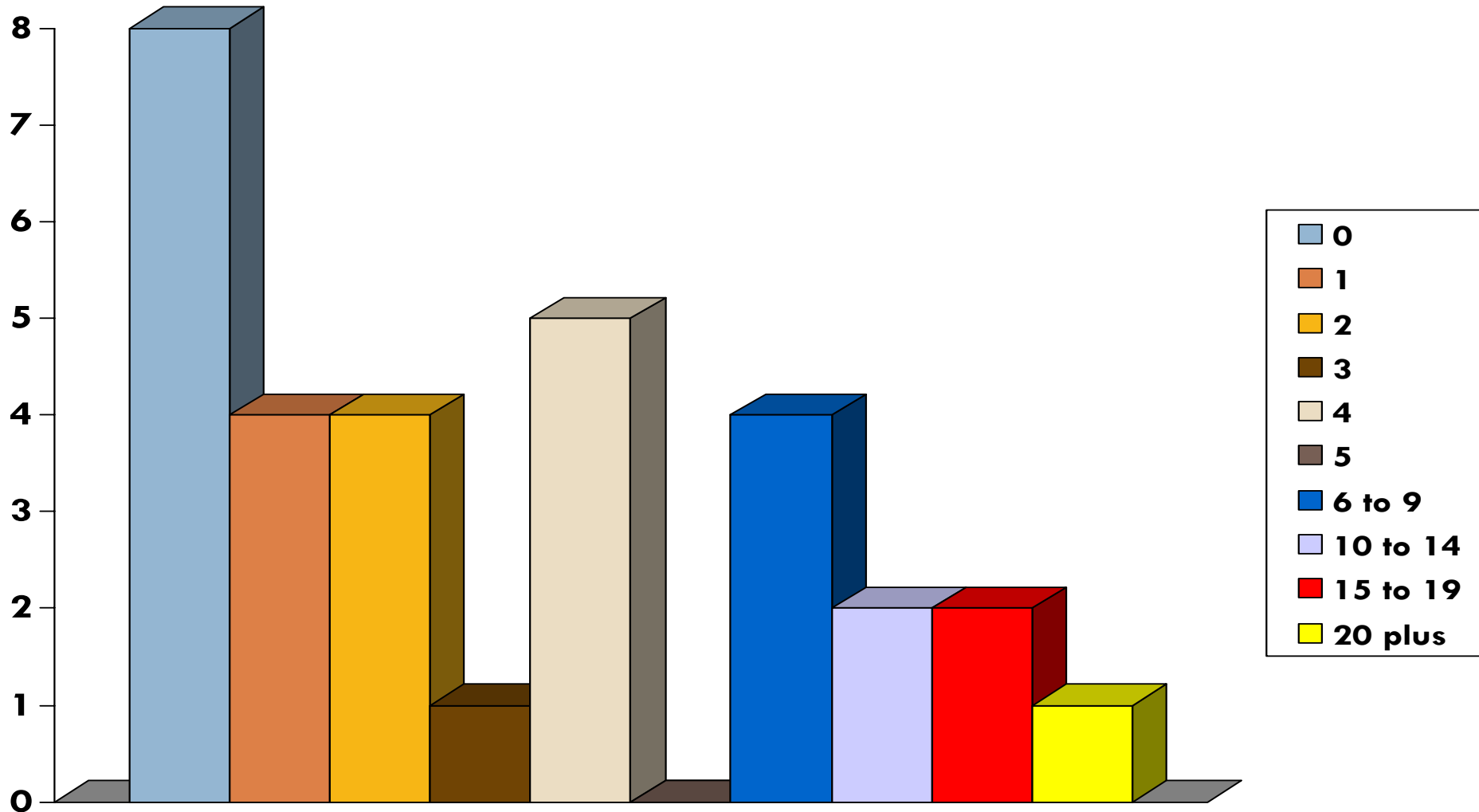
# How well do you think Kaleo's home groups are fostering healthy community?



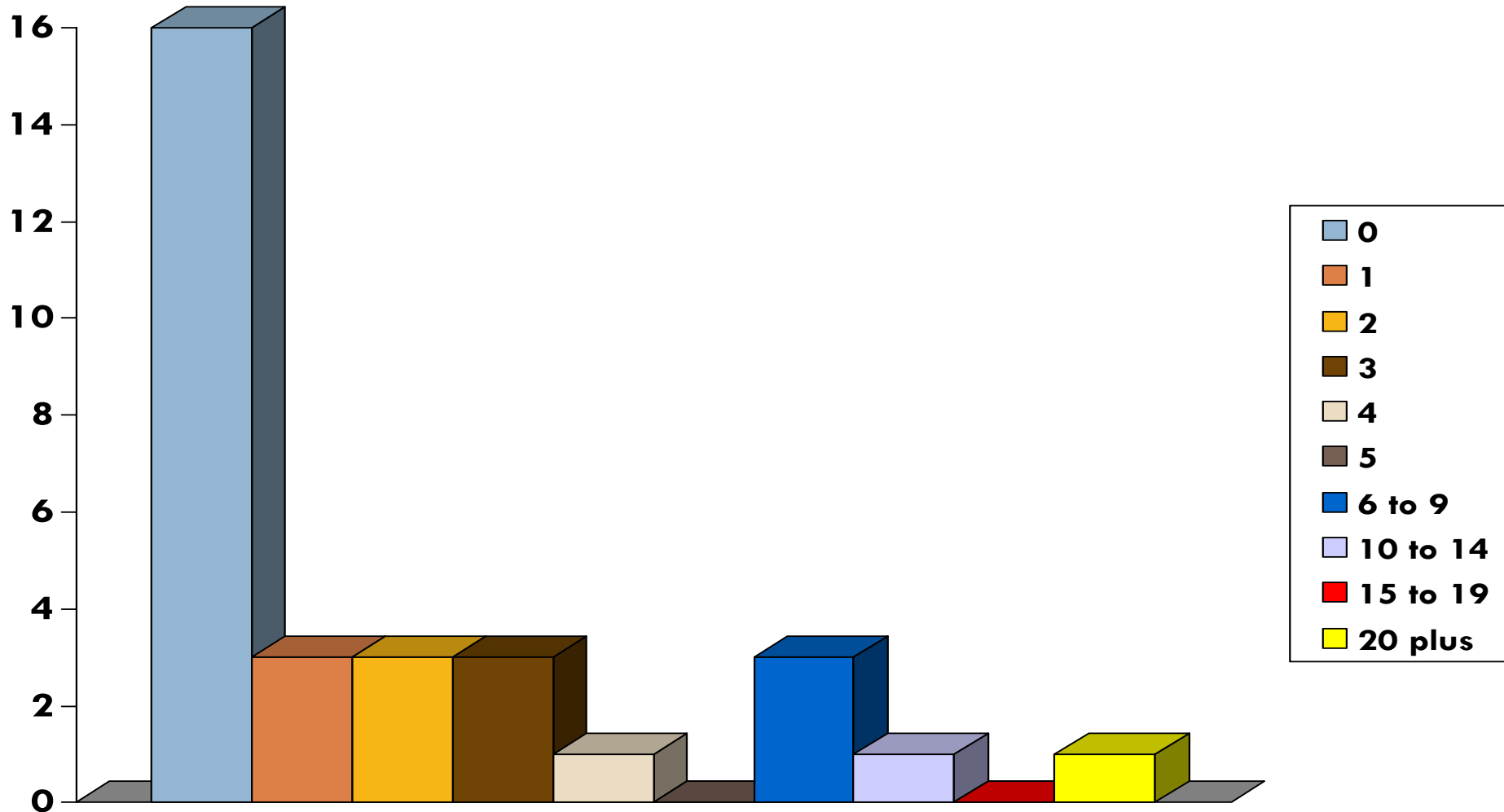
# How well do you feel your home group is preparing you to be on mission?



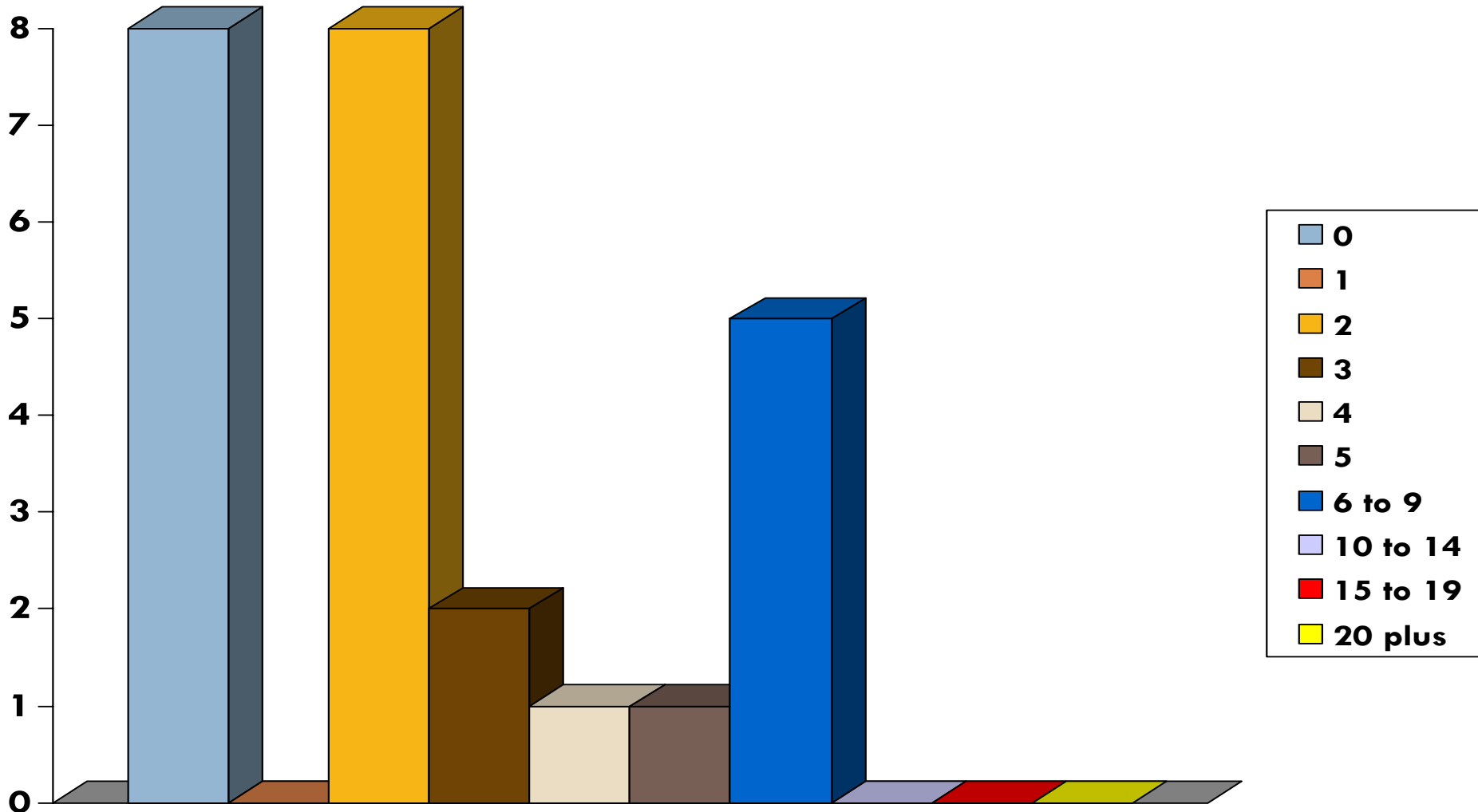
# In the past 90 days, how many people have you invited to a home group?

# How do you think Kaleo's home groups could be more missional?

1. We could do a better job of more regularly communicating the existence of our home groups and encouraging people to attend. 2. We could encourage leaders and attendees to be creative in organizing community social events or participating in local outreach projects. 3. We should encourage leaders and attendees to take "ownership" of their groups and actively look for ways to serve one another (e.g., throwing wedding or baby showers, taking meals to families with new babies, helping families move, etc.).
2. Assistance with articulating doctrines. More applicable skills for teaching others what we are learning. More comparing Christian doctrines to other world religions.
3. By inviting more of the unchurched.
4. By not just studying the text, but taking missional action as a group.
5. Connect the mercy ministries to the home groups.
6. Each home group should identify how they can work together to be more missional. This provides the opportunity for those who have the desire to be missional to lead and/or receive support from others, while it encourages those who wouldn't normally desire to be missional to do so with their home group family. This will help us all develop the mindset to reach out to our community with the gospel.

# How do you think Kaleo's home groups could be more missional? (..cont)

1. encouraging attendees to become involved in the current mercy ministries.
2. For my group: We need to be living life together outside of our group. As part of this, we should invite non-believing friends to join us in this time. We need to be showing a personal concern for helping out in the community where we meet, through some form of local mercy ministry. (We talked about cleaning up a park in the neighborhood).
3. Have some on Saturday mornings, so that they may go out into the community when they are done. Or, earlier in the evening (like 5pm or 6pm).
4. I think home groups can be a bit threatening to most non-believers, so I think the way that they can be missional is by the ways they equip us to go out and be missional..
5. Incorporate service to the neighborhood? Serve dinner (some or all home groups).
6. It has to be drawn out of the text, lived out by the leadership, and encouraged weekly and creatively.
